

	meaning of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.		
Contracts	Any contract made between the councillor or his/her spouse or		
	civil partner or the person with whom the		
	councillor is living as if they were		
	spouses/civil partners (or a firm in which		
	such person is a partner, or an incorporated body of which such person is		
	a director* or		
	a body that such person has a beneficial		
	interest in the securities of*) and the council —		
	(a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be		
	executed; and (b) which has not been fully discharged		
Land and property	(b) which has not been fully discharged. Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the council.		
	'Land' excludes an easement, servitude,

* 'director' includes a member of the committee of management of an industrial and provident society.

* 'securities' means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited with a building society.

Table 2: Other Registerable Interest

You must register as an Other Registerable Interest :

- 1. any unpaid directorships
- 2. any body of which you are a member or are in a position of general control or management and to which you are nominated or appointed by your authority
- 3. any body
 - (i) exercising functions of a public nature
 - (ii) directed to charitable purposes or
 - (iii) one of whose principal purposes includes the influence of public opinion or policy (including any political party or trade union) of which you are a member or in a position of general control or management
